Please find Licence fees and structure for the new Pétanque season year 2011-12

### **Licence:**

#### **(A) National Licence (Full licence) per Player \$50**

- Entitles the member to participate in all tournaments held in Australia
- Entitles the member to participate in his/her Club and State championships
- Entitles the member to participate in all PFA National championships
- Entitles the member to represent Australia Internationally (condition apply)

#### **(B) Club Licence (social licence) per player \$25**

- Entitles the member to participate in all open tournaments held in Australia
- Entitles the member to participate in his/her Club and interclub competitions

#### **Club Licence restriction:**

- The member cannot participate in any PFA National Championships (National open, Interstate challenge) and State championships
- The member cannot be a member of a National team representing Australia

#### **C) Junior Licence per player \$10 \_ Those less than 18years on 1<sup>st</sup> of July of the year**

- As per (A) National Licence
- Player can represent Australia at the Junior World Championship under specific condition (Age limit)

### **(D) Day licence per player \$10**

- Upon purchase of a Day Licence the holder is entitled to participate in all open tournament

#### **Day licence Restrictions**

- The holder cannot participate in any Championship (Club, State, National, interclub or international)
- The holder cannot represent Australia in any tournament
- A player is only entitled to purchase 3 day Licences per year

#### **Day Licence to be kept by the Competition Umpires**

- Day licence will be issued by the umpire.
- The Umpire must account for the number of licences issued accompanied by the prescribed form to the State Chief Umpire
- The State Umpire will be responsible for the policing of the 3 licences only rule in a Petanque calendar year
- The PFA will be responsible for the printing of the licence books
- The PFA treasurer will be responsible for good accounting of the Day licence fees
  - o \$2 fee to be retained by the organising club or committee
  - o \$3 Fee to be retained by the Umpire subject to a maximum of \$75. In the case of a big tournament the excess fee is to be kept by the State Umpire for Umpire fee in future tournaments
  - o The balance of \$5 to be remitted by the chief Umpire to the PFA who would use it for administration fees such as Insurance
